Registration

Registration must be done in person.

The first week of camp **chosen** must be paid in full at the time of registration. Each additional week of camp registration requires a **NON REFUNDABLE 25% DEPOSIT**. The balance is due by post dated cheques, Visa, Mastercard or American Express and dated **TWO WEEKS** prior to the start of the camp week that the camper(s) is registered.

Welcome to Camp!!!

Meeting new friends, learning new skills, and enjoying fun filled days in a caring, supervised environment is what YMCA Day Camp is all about! We are committed to giving your child the support, care and fun they deserve. Each of our camps will have their specialty, and participate in traditional camp games, songs, crafts, outdoor activities, swimming, dress up days and hot dog Fridays. Trips take place weeks 2-9. The YMCA Core Values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility and Inclusiveness are carefully and purposely integrated into all of our camp programs. YMCA Day Camps strive in making memories that last a lifetime.

Safety First

Sign In and Out Process

To ensure the safety and well-being of each camper, we require all campers to be signed in and out every day by a parent or guardian 18 years or older. Please inform the sign in staff daily if there are any custody issues or any other extenuating circumstances we should be aware of. In the event that a change needs to be made, we ask the parent/guardian to contact the Camp Director. Be prepared to provide picture identification when picking up campers.

At the YMCA of Central East Ontario, the safety of your child in our camp program is of the utmost importance. In order to remain safe, all campers will be given a wrist band that they are asked to wear all week when they are at camp. This bracelet will identify to all YMCA staff that your child belongs to a specific camp group, and will aid us in ensuring that the children are in the correct location and with the correct staff. These bracelets will also aid us when we are off site for field trips. Should your child need to remove the bracelet in the evenings for comfort or sports that is perfectly fine, it will be re-applied in the morning when they arrive at camp.

Refund/Cancellation Policy

The refund/cancellation policy is as follows:

- Must be made in writing by completing a "Program Cancellation Request Form" located at the Membership Sales and Service Desk
 - Refunds and credits must be requested at least 14 days prior to the start of the program
 - The 25% deposit made at the time of registration is non-refundable unless there is an extenuating circumstance (medical or emergency situation). The proper documentation is required for all cancellations and refunds for medical and emergency reasons
 - Refunds are not granted if a parent/guardian withdraws a camper early from the session
 - Refunds are not granted if a camper is sent home for misconduct
- ** The Camp Director makes the final decision as to who qualifies for refunds**

Since 1884, the YMCA has been training the leaders of the future. YMCA Youth Leader Corps programs are designed to help participants build skills that they can use for a lifetime! The program aims to provide a sense of responsibility for the well-being of others and a sound foundation of formal and supervised in-service training that prepares youth for future volunteer and employment opportunities.

Spending time with friends, trying new activities and having a great time is what Leader Corps is all about. Our Leader Corps participants work closely within a group of their peers and a staff advisor. Together, they learn how to work as a team, set goals and plan together, become involved in the community and discover ways to make a difference in the lives of others.

Through involvement in the program, our participants learn about working with and getting along with others. More importantly, in time, our leaders begin to understand themselves and their own individual strengths.

YMCA Youth Leader Corps Programs feature three components: Values Based Leadership Training – skills such as communication and teaching.
